- 2) The applicant's maturity and knowledge,
- 3) The applicant's demonstrated interest in department programs, and
- 4) The availability of adult supervision.

Juvenile volunteers must be assigned an adult supervisor. Arrangements for this supervision must be approved by the California Department of Parks and Recreation.

I expressly release Los Angeles Audubon, their officers, directors, employees, agents licensees, successors and assigns from and for any and all claims, demands or causes of action which I have or may have, including claims for (i) libel, defamation, invasion of privacy or right of publicity arising from Los Angeles Audubon's use of my child's appearance, name, likeness, voice and biographical information, including but not limited to, the distribution, broadcast or exhibition thereof, or (ii) on account of any loss, damage, or injury to person or property suffered or incurred by my child, except by Los Angeles Audubon's negligence, in connection with any aspect of my child's participation in the Program or in any Program-related activity, including any transportation arranged by, paid for or provided by Los Angeles Audubon.

I expressly waive all rights under Section 1542 of the Civil Code of California, which reads as follows: A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which if known by him must have materially affected his settlement with the debtor.
